

Percussionists need to be good students who are reliable.

"Do I need to know anything about music to start playing an instrument?"



NO -- You will learn about reading music and playing your instrument here at school once every week. Lessons are during the school day but if you are absent, you will miss important needed skills. Try to be at every lesson and every rehearsal.

What does it cost?

All the instruments can be rented from local music stores.

Rental fees are usually between \$20 - \$40 per month.

School lessons are free.

RUSD has some school instruments available at a reduced cost. Please contact your teacher if interested.


Will we have a concert?



Yes -- We have concerts this year so you can show off what you've learned for your family and friends!!



Will it hurt my grades in the classroom?



Instrumental music students tend to do better in academic classes such as math and reading. Students will miss 30 minutes of a class to come to lessons once per week. They are responsible for completing any work they miss while at their lessons.

Do I play my instrument at home?



YES - Students are expected to play their instrument at home 20 - 30 minutes per day, 5 days per week. Band is a graded subject and practicing at home is important.
