"Do I need to know anything about music to start playing an instrument?"

Rental fees are between \$18 and \$33 per

School lessons are free.




Will we have a concert?



Yes -- We have two concerts already scheduled and we need to get started right away.

Will it hurt my grades in the classroom?



Instrumental music students tend to do better in academic classes such as math and reading. Students will miss 30 minutes of a class to come to lessons once per week. They are responsible for completing any work they miss while at their lessons.

Do I play my instrument at home?



YES - Students are expected to play their instrument at home 30 minutes per day, 5 days per week. ORCHESTRA is a graded subject and practicing at home is important.
