Use of Tobacco Products

The use of tobacco products on school premises is contrary to the educational goals of the District. For this reason, all persons including, but not limited to students, employees, independent contractors and members of the general public, are prohibited from using any and all forms of tobacco products on premises owned, rented by, or under the control of the District at any time. (This includes contracted buildings and athletic fields that the District rents or uses for school-sponsored events.)

For the purpose of interpreting this policy, premises includes all buildings, grounds and motor vehicles owned, rented or leased by the District. The District does not allow the use of tobacco products on District premises even if the District premises are rented to another person for non-educational purposes.

Employees and students will fall under already established policies for discipline. All other persons will be asked to refrain from doing so. If the person fails to comply, he/she will be requested to leave the premises. If problems persist, law enforcement authorities will be called to remove the person.
