Political Campaigns

During political campaigns, staff observes the following guidelines:

1. Workers from outside the school who seek to recruit students for political campaigns may not do so on school district property or time.
2. The formation of such clubs as Young Democrats or Young Republicans is not precluded as long as they are organized according to school rules on student clubs.
3. Social studies classes or student assemblies may invite candidates for a particular office to speak before them as long as all candidates for that office are invited.
