



Youth Volunteer Opportunity Details:

- •The YVC program works with students between the ages of 11-18 only.
- •We will be practicing social distancing, and masks will be required for indoor events (when outside, and 6ft apart I allow students to choose if they want to wear it or not).
- •Students must have a parent waiver filled out to participate. The waiver can be emailed back, or students can bring their waiver on the first day they come to volunteer. If they already filled one out, they don't need to again. The waiver is attached to this email.
- •Students must make sure they have transportation for each volunteer opportunity at the specified times. Youth Volunteers cannot be left alone to wait for a ride, per program policy. Picking up a youth volunteer late habitually, can result in the youth volunteer not being able to volunteer with YVC.
- •To sign up for a volunteer opportunity, the students should use the Sign-Up-Genius link provided. Space is limited so they must sign up to attend.
- Additional details for each youth volunteer opportunity will be sent out to those attending prior to each event.
- •Students should dress for the weather (hat, sunscreen, jacket, etc.) and bring their own water and mask.
