## Title 1 Schoolwide Program

Title I is a federal program that provides funds to school districts and schools with high numbers or high percentages of disadvantaged children. Its overall purpose is to ensure that all children have a fair, equal and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and assessments.

Schoolwide programs serve all children in a school. All staff, resources, and classes are part of the overall Schoolwide program. The purpose is to generate high levels of academic achievement in core subject areas for all students, especially those students most in need. This purpose is achieved through high quality instruction, comprehensive reform strategies and methods that are based on the use of scientifically based research, strategies and methods to improve teacher quality and professional development and consolidated use of funds.



## RAISING RACINE 2022

Ensure experiences, opportunities and choice so every RUSD student is academically, socially and emotionally successful and ready for career and/or college.

**Four-year graduation rate from 76.8% to meet or exceed state average by 2022.**

**ACT: Eleventh grade students at or above the CCR Benchmark:**

- Math: from 15.2% to 25.2%
- Reading: from 21.4% to 31.4%

**Ninth grade students earning 7 high school credits (including math-Algebra 1 or higher) from 60.5% to 80%.**

**Forward Exam: 7th grade students scoring proficient/advanced increased by 15%:**

- Math: from 12.6% to 27.6%
- ELA: from 20.4% to 35.4%

**MAP at the CCR Benchmark increase by 15%:**

- 3rd grade students reading from 23.5% to 38.5%
- 5th grade students math from 23.7% to 38.7%

## Julian Thomas Elementary School Goals

### Reading Goals:

- Increase the percent of students at/above proficiency on the Forward Exam from 11.1% to 18.1%
- Increase the percent of students at college/career ready benchmark on spring MAP from 18.8% to 21.8%

### Math Goals:

- Increase the percent of students at/above proficiency on the Forward Exam from 14.3% to 26.3%
- Increase the percent of students at college/career ready benchmark on spring MAP from 26.6% to 29.6%

### Culture & Environment Goals:

- Reduce black suspension rates from 57% to 50%
- Increase the average daily attendance for all students from 92.6% to 95%
