

ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) PREREQUISITES

For a student to be eligible for Advanced Placement classes in tenth, eleventh and/or twelfth grade, it is advisable for them to take the accelerated classes in the earlier grades. THIS ACTUALLY STARTS IN MIDDLE SCHOOL!
