

SUGGESTED ADVANCED PLACEMENT (AP) COURSE SEQUENCING

If a student is interested in taking Advanced Placement classes in high school, it is advisable for them to take the accelerated classes in the earlier grades.

The following chart shows the typical sequence of accelerated classes
(*placement is often based on MAP scores, teacher recommendations & student interest*):
