Business

School Board and Transportation

- 1. The District shall comply with applicable student transportation policies and regulations prescribed or established by the State of Wisconsin, the Wisconsin Motor Vehicle Division, the Department of Public Instruction, and the Department of Transportation.
- 2. The Board shall:
 - a. Contract with a qualified private operator(s) and/or the local public transit system for its student transportation service.
 - b. Require the contractor to meet specifications established by the School Board.
- 3. The Superintendent or designee shall establish all bus routes and shall authorize any route changes.
- 4. The following policy shall govern the conduct of all bus riders:
 - a. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their child's behavior on the bus.
 - b. Violations of bus riding rules and regulations in Administrative Regulation 3700 may result in the suspension of bus riding privileges. (See Administrative Regulation 3700.)
