Extracurricular Activities and Trips

- 1. Transportation to an extracurricular activity or trip must be in a school bus, motor bus, or motor vehicle operated under Wisconsin Statute 121.555(1)(a). The school principal must authorize the use of such transportation and may only authorize such use if the school has an actual interest in the safety and welfare of the children transported to the activity.
- 2. The coach or teacher shall have complete responsibility for supervising students. A certified staff person must be present on site for the supervision of all athletic events, practice sessions, rehearsals or school activities.
- 3. All students shall conduct themselves in accordance with proper school vehicle conduct.
- 4. The staff person shall adequately instruct the students about procedures to follow in case of emergencies.
- 5. The coach or representative is completely responsible for all athletic equipment.
- 6. The maximum seating for football players shall be two (2) players per seat.
- 7. The aisle shall be kept free of equipment carried on the bus by the activity participants.
