Instruction

1. Examination and Grading (6146)

Measurements of achievement and reports of progress will be provided in conjunction with the Instructional standards established in the curriculum.

High school students will be allowed to retake subjects for a second time for no additional credit. The higher grade and grade point of the repeated subject would substitute for the original course and grade point on the student's official transcript. Both attempts and grades will appear on the transcript as they represent historical data for the students. However, the lower grade will not be calculated in the GPA. In order to retake subjects, students must have the approval of their department chair, counselor and school principal.

To the extent possible, all examinations shall be free of bias.

The school board shall do all of the following annually:

- a. Formally adopt educational standards for all subject areas.
- b. Formally notify parents of adopted educational standards.
- c. Administer all required state assessments as described by the Wisconsin DPI.
- d. Formally notify parents of all required state assessments as described by the Wisconsin DPI that will be administered during the respective school year in accordance with Administrative Regulation 6162.61.
