Instruction

a. Homework/Outside Assignments (6146.1)

A major goal of education is to have students able to apply knowledge, skills and study habits acquired in school throughout their careers and lives.

To promote independent learning and to extend learning time, students in District schools should expect and teachers should assign homework and outside assignments.

At each of the levels, the nature of the assignments will vary according to the abilities of the students and the requirements of the individual courses.
