Every Racine Unified graduate must meet the following requirements:

- District graduation requirements
- Participate in a Career Pathway course sequence
- Complete an Academic and Career Plan

To be college and/or career ready, graduates must also accomplish indicators as described below.

College Ready Indicators

College Ready: student who meets all three of the indicators will be considered **High School Ready**.

- Growth/Proficiency in the identified RUSD Content Skills
 - English & Language Arts (ELA)
 - Math
 - Science
 - Social Studies
- Growth/Proficiency on RUSD Writing Assessment
- Completion of Academic portion of Academic and Career Plan (ACP)

Career Ready Indicators

Career Ready: Any student who meets four or more of the Career Ready Indicators will be considered **High School Ready**.

- Completion of Career portion of Academic and Career Plan (ACP)
- Completion of a Career-based Learning Experience (CBLE)
- Successful completion of two Career & Technical Education courses
- One or more career ready certifications earned
- Participated in two or more school organized co-/extra curricular activities
- Fifteen or more community service hours
- Maintains 90% or above attendance rate

Life Ready Indicators

Critical for Both College & Career Ready Graduates

- Completion of a financial literacy curriculum or experience
- Completion of cyber safety curriculum or experience
- Assessed or reflected upon the professional skills:
 - Accountability/Dependability
 - Collaboration & Leadership
 - Professional Responsibility
 - Ethics
