My Choice, My Future

Dear Parents and Guardians,

We have had a wonderful fall at Gifford School! We are excited about the progress our elementary students are making with the focus on literacy and the launch of the Academies in the middle school. As a learning community, we are continually looking to improve student achievement in English Language Arts and Mathematics. The school report card is one resource we use to reflect on our strengths and areas for improvement.

The Department of Public Instruction (DPI) is required by state statute ([Wis. Stat. 115.385](#)) to generate a school report card and district report card for every publicly funded school and district in the state. The report cards are intended to help schools and districts use performance data to celebrate successes and improve their efforts to prepare students for their futures. The current **school report card is primarily based on last year's performance during the 2021-22 school year**. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, DPI encourages caution when interpreting scores and ratings on the 2021-22 report cards.

At the foundation of the report cards are four priority areas. Schools and districts receive a score for each priority area:

- **Achievement** - proficiency in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics on the annual state assessments
- **Growth** - year-to-year progress in ELA and math achievement
- **Target Group Outcomes** - outcomes for students with the lowest test scores: the Target Group.
- **On-Track to Graduation** - reliable predictors of how successfully students are progressing toward completing their K-12 education.

The priority area scores are aggregated into an overall accountability score, from 0 to 100. This score is displayed on the front page of the school or district report cards. It is important to note that the 0 to 100 accountability score is not a "percent correct" measurement. Based on its score, a school or district receives one of five rating categories, from *Fails to Meet Expectations* to *Significantly Exceeds Expectations*, as well as corresponding one to five stars.

Here is some information we would like to share from Gifford's report card:

Gifford remained in the *Meets Expectations* category with a slight increase in our score from last year to 62.8. In the Achievement priority area, all sub categories showed growth in mathematics. In the Growth Priority area for English Language Arts Black or African American students showed a slightly higher than average growth. We are pleased with these small gains. We will continue to focus our attention in the areas of Mathematics and English Language Arts to increase the number of students on track to graduate and prepare them to be career and college ready.

I want to share these results with you because they help illuminate some of our successes and help pinpoint areas of focus at Gifford. But as DPI stresses, these report cards are just one source of information about our school. Here are some additional results that show we are moving in the right direction.

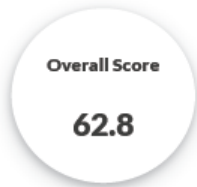
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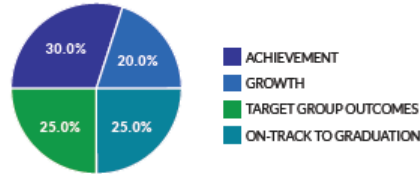

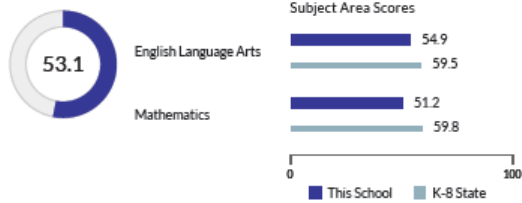

PRIORITY AREA WEIGHTS

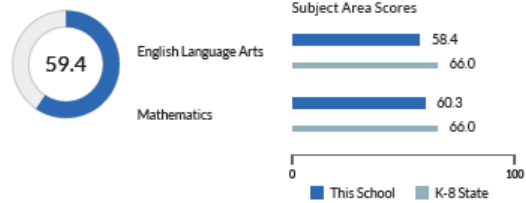


Priority Area Scores

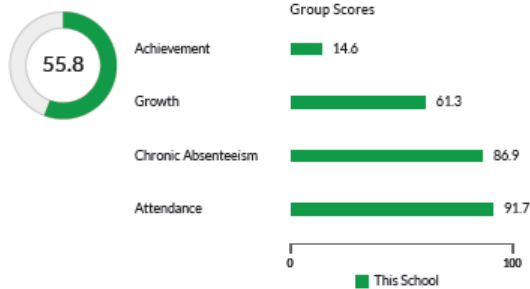

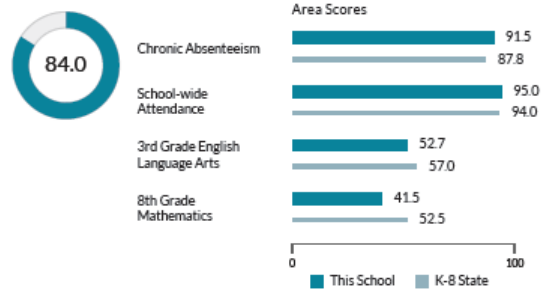
