We are excited to participate in this year's National PTA Reflections Program, a competition that invites students to make and submit original works of art in response to a student-selected theme. This 50+ year-old program helps students explore their thoughts, feelings and ideas, develop artistic literacy, and increase confidence.

The theme for the 2020-2021 program year is *I Matter Because.../Yo importo porque...* This year's theme was submitted by a 1<sup>st</sup> grader, Rylee Stier, who drew inspiration from her town being impacted by wildfires in California in 2018. With the call for meaningful steps to dismantle

structural racism, this theme provides new meaning and an opportunity to engage and elevate the voices of students of color. This is a priority, now more than ever.

Students submit original works of art in the categories of Photography, Visual Arts (welcomes all visual media), or Special Artists (welcomes students from all grades and abilities and offers non-artistic accommodations for all students to participate fully in PTA Reflections). Our local winners will be reviewed on the creativity and originality they bring to the theme and will have the opportunity to move to the state and

national level. More importantly, we will give our students an opportunity to express themselves through art and a platform to gather and display these works for one another.

## Cooking with Kiddos—No-Bake Honey Nut Cheerios Snack Bars

These fast & easy bars use ingredients you likely have on hand and allow for substitution for almost any dried fruit, nut, or seed. Perfect for a grab-and-go snack and spending a little time with your kiddos in the kitchen.

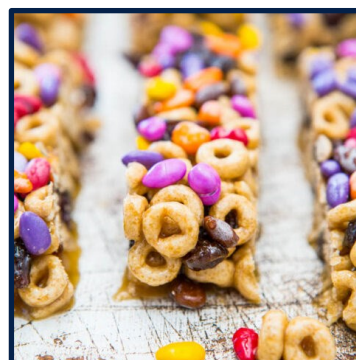
**Yield:** One 8-By-8-Inch Pan, 12 Snack Bars **Prep:** 10 Minutes

### Ingredients:

- 1/4 cup unsalted butter
- 1/4 cup honey (light-colored corn syrup may be substituted and will keep the bars firmer at room temp than using honey)
- 1/4 cup light brown sugar, packed
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 3 cups Honey Nut Cheerios
- 1 cup raisins, optional (1 cup honey-roasted peanuts, 1 cup chopped almonds, or 1 cup trail mix may be substituted)
- about 1/2 cup chocolate-covered sunflower seeds, optional
- pinch sea salt (helps to cut the sweetness)

### Instructions:

1. Line an 8-inch square pan with aluminum foil leaving overhang, spray with cooking spray; set aside.
2. In a large microwave-safe bowl, combine butter, honey, brown sugar, and heat on high power for 1 minute to melt.
3. Stop to stir. Mixture will be on the granular side, this is okay.
4. Return bowl to microwave and heat for 1 more minute on high power. Stop to stir.
5. Return bowl to microwave and heat for 1 more minute on high power. Stop to stir. On this third and final burst, mixture will become quite bubbly and foamy; use caution when removing from micro because this is boiling hot caramel and can cause burns.
6. Stir in the vanilla using caution because mixture could bubble up.
7. Stir in the cereal.
8. Stir in the optional raisins (or nuts).
9. Turn mixture out into prepared pan, packing it down firmly with a spatula and smoothing the top.
10. Sprinkle evenly with sunflower seeds and salt.
